January 15 ${ }^{\text {th }}, 2024$

## Approval of Minutes from October:

- Motion to approve minutes put forward by Andrew, seconded by Rob, all in favour.


## Principal's Report:

- The school newsletter is coming out this week regarding the following information.
- Grade 10 Provincial Assessments are happening next week - the students will write the literacy assessment on Tuesday and numeracy on Thursday.
- Thursday, January $25^{\text {th }}$ is report card day. Reports will be posted on My-Ed.
- Grade 9s have immunizations on Friday.
- Grade 11s will write the grade 12 literacy assessment this coming April. This is beneficial for those applying for early admission in grade 12.
- Grade 12 s - now is the time to be looking at scholarships. Both IHUB counsellors have experience applying for scholarships, including essay writing and letters of reference. Some scholarships have very few applicants, so it's worth the effort to apply. If the student finds the scholarship, the school will help with the application process.
- IHUB interviews for new grade 9 students are going very well.
- Europe Trip - There is enough interest for the trip to go ahead. Approximately 29 students have signed up so far. Registration will continue up to the end of the school year. Capacity depends on having enough adult supervision.

## - Online store for Inquiry Hub

- Idea proposed to the PAC.
- Set up an online store in which the students can upload their designs, and families can order those designs on selected products such as hoodies, mugs, etc.
- PAC to set up the store.
- Once the store is set up, IHUB will select a lead person to run the store and a process by which to determine how many designs are offered.
- PAC to handle the fundraising aspect. However, the goal here isn't a significant fundraiser, but rather to support the school/students by making student designs accessible to the school community.
- Items in the store would be available for order all year as an ongoing fundraiser.
- PAC continuing to investigate available platforms.
- Redbubble was investigated and deemed not a viable option due to high fees. Utilizing this platform would cost the PAC money.
- TeePublic is being investigated as an option.
- Andrew confirmed that the PAC would not have to pay tax on any income generated from running this online store.
- Dave and Stephanie will look into additional platforms prior to the next PAC meeting.
- Need to clarify the copyright. Dave to reach out to the district for clarification.
- PAC agreed that any students wishing to have their designs uploaded must have a parent-signed permission form with full transparency on copyright and fundraising.
o Note: If any parents with experience or interest in running an online store wish to help with this initiative, please contact the PAC.


## Update from Matthew on Grade 12 Grad Initiatives:

- Through student fundraising $\$ 200$ has been raised for grad.
- Students are still deciding what they are doing for grad in regard to after grad and a class trip. Aquarium trip is a potential idea.
- No designs for hoody's yet. This will be looked into following end of semester exams.
- Grad Photos. Many students opted out of the grad photos offered through Centennial due to cost. Students are setting up their own photo shoots at the school to provide graduates with another, more cost-effective, opportunity for grade photos. February is the target timeline.
- PAC confirmed that funds from one of the Me N'Eds fundraisers will be donated to support Grade 12 grad activities.
- Note: Matthew has an archive of student designs and videos over the past 4 years. Discussion regarding who to transfer this to after Matthew graduates.
- Matthew and Vincent run the snack fund. PAC will fund it at $\$ 10$ a month moving forward (as previously agreed).
- This ran previously as a donation model but has moved to a fundraising model. Appropriate donations are still accepted, such as low clean-up food items, with little waste, and low effort meals. Items that are easy to prepare "if all you have is water, a microwave and a utensil."
